According to the Department for Education, BAME individuals are significantly underrepresented across the education sector, from primary and secondary school to colleagues and universities. In 2016, only 7% of headteachers in primary schools and 9% in secondary schools were from an Ethnic Minority background. While this has increased by 2% since 2010, more needs to be done to correct this overwhelming imbalance.
